Key Duties:

Responsibilities include mapping ground conditions during construction, coordinating field activities with contractors and drillers, logging exploration drilling activity and details of retrieved cores, performing site visits to observe and monitor construction progress and assist with immediate needs of design or construction issues that arise, proposal and report writing, and data analysis. This position typically consists of a 50/50 split between office and field duties. This position requires independent judgment, and the successful candidate must have effective communication with construction personnel, and to relay information to Principal Tunnel Consultant and/or Principal Engineer.

- B.S. degree in Geology required;
- M.S. degree preferred, or 1 to 2 years of consulting experience may be substituted;
- Assistant level (0-2 years) or Associate level (3-5 years) of work related experience.
